THE PEACEMAKER | Peaceful Mediator

The Easygoing, Self-Effacing Type: Receptive, Reassuring, Stable, and Indecisive

INTRODUCTION: Nines are accepting, trusting, and stable. They are usually creative, optimistic, and supportive, but can also be too willing to go along with others to keep the peace.

CORE FEARS: Loss and separation.

BASIC DESIRE: To have inner stability "peace of mind".

HOW I TYPICALLY COMMUNICATE:

-When I'm doing well, I am kind, a good listener, easy to be with, receptive, open, nonjudgmental, peaceful, optimistic, warm, and fully engaged with others and life.

-When I'm not doing well, I can meander in my talk-style since I am unsure of what I think and feel. I can be passive aggressive, detached, stubborn, and avoid conflict by going along to get along.

What Leads To Conflict:

1. Being told what to do instead of being asked.
2. Peace and harmony being disrupted.
3. Being confronted directly and expected to state their thoughts and views immediately.

How To Show Nines Love:

1. Tell them and show them their presence matters.
2. It means a lot when you listen to them without interrupting.
3. Pursue engaging discussions and avoid hostile confrontations.

What Can We Learn From Nines:

Proactive-Christ-like-sacrificial-love is exactly what the people around us need!
