HELPFUL INFORMATION ON HOW TO SCHEDULE YOUR VACCINE APPOINTMENTS

PURPOSE CHURCH

The following information is gleaned from the various government and county sites and is current as of 2/3/2021. We hope it will be useful and is supplied as a courtesy to our precious seniors as you navigate the necessary steps to obtain an appointment to receive a Covid-19 Vaccine.

Some seniors who have obtained a vaccine have shared that some of the different options that are offered are easier than others. **Some recommend calling 211 (Seniors Help Line 24/7) and although they had to wait 1 - 2 hours, they found it easier and less frustrating than the online option. If you choose to use the online option the sites release new data at midnight and people have been successful to get appointments at that time.**

Los Angeles County

Residents who are 65 years old and older can now register for COVID-19 vaccination appointments. Residents in this high-priority age group with internet access should visit [VaccinateLACounty.com](https://vaccinateLACounty.com) to schedule their appointments.

This week the County of Los Angeles announced an additional COVID-19 vaccine appointment scheduling site: [My Turn](#). My Turn does not allow the creation of a profile or alerts but will let you know if there are appointments immediately available in your area. If there are no appointments available, please continue to check back as more appointments will be added.

San Bernardino County

Riverside County

Residents who want to get vaccinated can visit the new Riverside University Health System Public Health vaccine website www.rivcoph.org/COVID-19-Vaccine starting at noon Saturday for an appointment. Residents 65 years of age or older who need help registering for an appointment, can [call 211](tel:211).

Please note: In order to increase access for our most vulnerable populations, appointments for the County's vaccination clinics as part of today's (Jan. 28) release are for residents age 85 and older ONLY. Must show proof of age at time of appointment.

Purpose Church

Some of you have heard the announcement by Pastor Glenn about Purpose Church being used as a vaccine distribution site. This is a **One Day Only event** on March 4 (with the 2nd vaccine dose follow up later in March or early April). This is being put on by the LA County as part of their plan to distribute more vaccines in specific areas. It will be held in the north parking lot.

If you wanted this appointment location you would still have to sign up through the normal LA County channels. Purpose Church is only supplying the parking lot.
