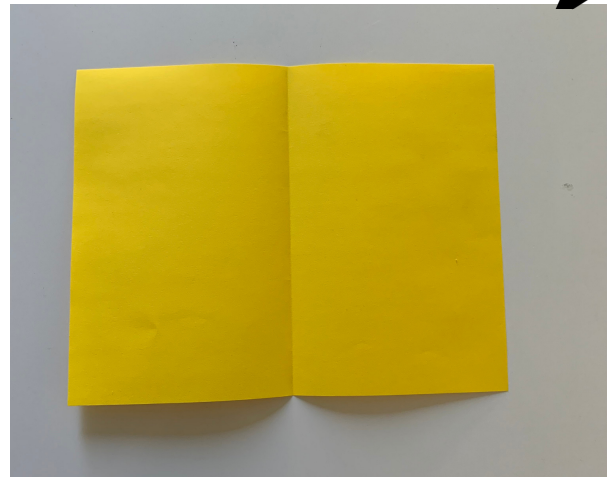




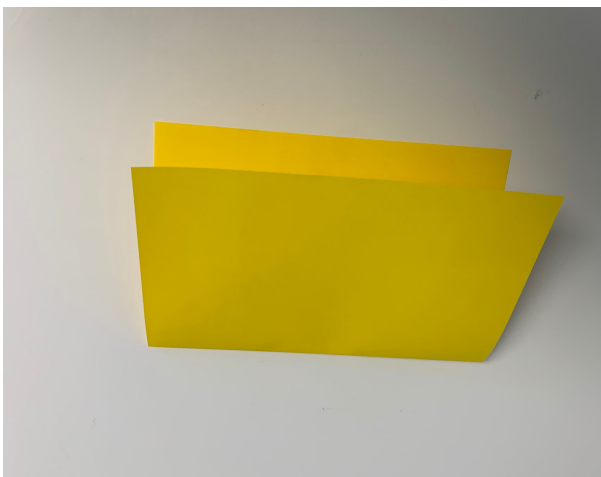
STEP 1

You will need a rectangular piece of paper, string, a pencil, stapler & staples, scissors, and a hole punch.



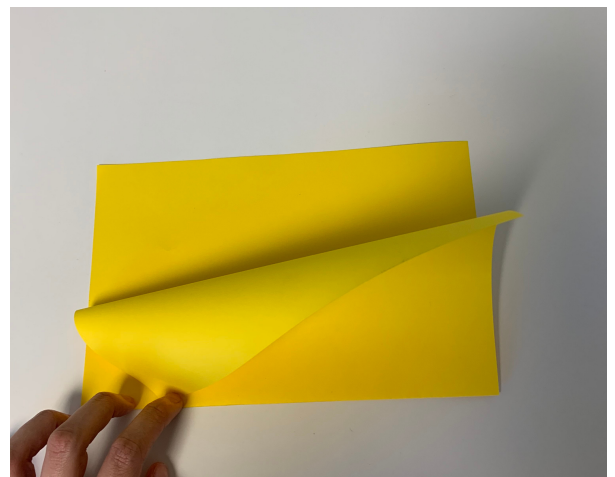
STEP 2

Fold paper in half width-ways, like a hamburger! Now is a great time to decorate your kite.



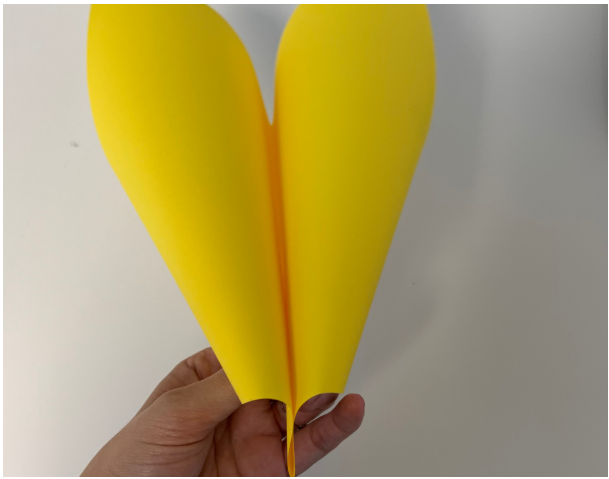
STEP 3

Set your folded paper down just like this.



STEP 4

Bend the front corner of the top layer down to touch the crease. Do not fold the paper, only bend.



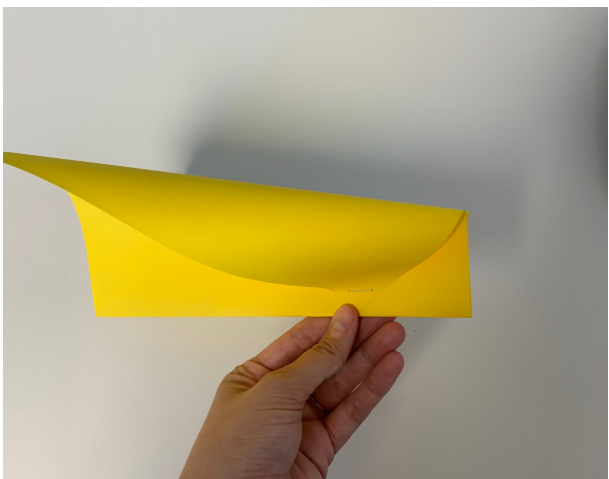
STEP 5

Repeat step 4 on the other half of the paper until you can hold it like this.



STEP 6

Staple your paper where you were holding the bended corners in place.



STEP 7

Once it is stapled, It will look something like this!



STEP 8

Make a hole near the front of the crease (towards the "nose" of the kite)



STEP 9

Thread your string through the hole you just made.



STEP 10

Tie a knot to keep the string in place!



STEP 11

Cut the left over string, we don't want it to weigh down our kite!



STEP 12

Wrap the string around a pencil so that you can control it better. Admire your work, and then HAVE FUN!
