It takes 2 hours 24 minutes to read the Book of Deuteronomy

Content: Rehearsal of the covenant for a new generation of Israelites just before the conquest of the Promised Land

Historical coverage: During the final weeks east of the Jordan River

Emphasis: The oneness and uniqueness of Yahweh, the God of Israel, over against all other gods; Yahweh's covenant love for Israel in making them His people; Yahweh's universal sovereignty over all peoples; Israel as Yahweh's model for the nations; the significance of the central sanctuary where Yahweh is to be worshiped; Yahweh's concern for justice - that His people reflect His character; the blessings of obedience and the dangers of disobedience.
