Content: 150 psalms of rich diversity, which were a "playlist" for the Jewish people.

Date of composition: 1000 B.C. - 400 B.C.

Emphasis: Trust in and praise to God for his goodness; lament over wickedness and injustices; God as king of the universe and the nations; Israel's king as God's representative in Israel; Israel (and individual Israelites) as God's covenant people; Zion (and it's temple) as the special place of God's presence on earth. *Gordon D.
