BACKGROUND FOR NAHUM

It takes 7 minutes to read Nahum

Content: A prophecy of God's judgment against Nineveh (Assyria) for her oppression, cruelty, and idolatry, concluding with the destruction of the city.

Prophet: Nahum, from Judah, otherwise unknown (even his hometown is uncertain).

Date of Prophetic Activity: Sometime before the fall of Nineveh in 612 B.C., during the period of Judah's being under the control of Assyria.

Emphasis: God's sovereignty over all the nations; God's execution of justice against cruelty; God's overthrow of the arrogant who think of themselves as invincible. *Gordon D. Fee & Douglas Stuart*

IMPORTANT DATES

- 785 B.C. Jonah prophesied against Nineveh and the people of Nineveh repent, but later go back to their old ways.
- 722 B.C. Nineveh (Assyria) destroys the northern kingdom of Israel, but God spares the southern kingdom of Judah.
- 663 B.C. Nineveh (Assyria) is at the height of its power after it defeats Egypt.
- 650 B.C. Nahum prophesied against Ninveveh (Assyria).
- 612 B.C. Nineveh (Assyria) is destroyed by Babylon never to be significant again in human history.
