



## **MISSION ROLE**

### **SPANISH PASTOR**

**Job Family:** Local Missions

**Reporting Relationship:** Responsible to the Local Missions Pastor

**Role Summary:** To develop and lead ministry to our spanish-speaking community, Purpose en Español.

#### **What you'll do:**

- Preach and lead Sunday morning services in Spanish and provide translation support to the broad church upon request.
- Engage the congregation in a program of outreach and discipleship. This includes Rooted, Microsites, community outreaches and additional discipleship programs.
- Recruit and train a team of leaders to assist with ministry needs including: Next Gen ministries, worship, small group leaders, preaching/teaching ministries, etc.
- Administer ordinances, perform marriages, conduct funerals, and engage in pastoral care.
- Attend in-person & virtual staff meetings and other meetings as required by the Lead Pastor. Staff Rally & Department meetings usually occur on Tuesdays.
- Ensure programs and activities are aligned with Purpose Church vision, mission, and core values.

#### **Commitments:**

- Must make Purpose Church your home church and agree with the vision, mission, and value statements of Purpose Church.
- Must agree with and abide by the Statement of Faith and Church Practices of Purpose Church.
- Must align with the Culture Values of Purpose Church.

#### **What you'll need:**

- Degree in biblical studies or pastoral ministry. Post graduate studies preferred.
- 5 years preaching/teaching experience.
- Must have a passion for seeing Spanish speaking people evangelized and discipled.
- Must demonstrate strong written and spoken communication skills.
- Ability to work and collaborate with Purpose church staff and pastors, and church members.
- Computer skills including knowledge of mainstream word processing programs, Google Suite, Social Media platforms, digital communication methods, etc.
