ROLE SUMMARY:

• Work directly with the Next Gen Pastor and the Young Adults Ministry (YA) team to collaborate, envision, and execute strategic planning and growth in a way that helps us fulfill our vision to see every young adult everywhere following Jesus.

WHAT YOU WILL DO:

- Strategically plan and cast vision for the Young Adults Ministry (ages 18-35).
- Recruit, lead, and empower YA team of staff and volunteers to serve in the bi-weekly Young Adult Thursday Nights through greeting, worship, teaching, and other aspects of the evening.
- Preach regularly in YA Thursday Nights and in other Next Gen and adult ministries and venues when possible.
- Recruit, develop, coach, and retain Young Adult Life Group Leaders.
- Develop a mentoring culture by recruiting and equipping mentors to develop mentoring relationships with young adults.
- Intentionally connect with Young Adults on Sunday mornings and throughout the week to connect them to YA and Groups.
- Responsible for implementing a graduate transition program annually, working with the High School Ministry (HSM) team and recruiting YAs to lead.
- Collaborate with the communications team to promote YA Groups and/or events through all avenues of communication (social media, web, promo materials, video announcements, etc.)
- Collaborate with and offer input to the Next Gen team in meetings and plans to help unify processes and transitions for kids, students, and young adults.

WHAT YOU WILL NEED:

- Must make Purpose Church your home church and agree with the vision, mission, and value statements of Purpose Church.
- Must agree with and abide by the Statement of Faith and Church Practice of Purpose Church.
- Must align with the Culture Values of Purpose Church.
- Must be a self-starter, stay organized, meet deadlines, and work well under pressure.
- Must have a passion for growing in your relationship with Jesus through Scripture, prayer, and serving–and leading teams in a Biblical way.
- Must have an ability to connect well with Young Adults and preach in a way that connects, challenges, and encourages young adults in their relationships with Jesus.
- Must pursue consistent awareness of changing culture themes, trends, and norms.
- Must be supportive of and invested in the life group philosophy and strategy for evangelism and discipleship and the importance of raising up volunteer leaders.
- Must be passionate about serving in a mid-urban, diverse, multiethnic, and multigenerational ministry context.



- Must exhibit the ability to resolve conflict in a Biblical and healthy way.
- Must have two years of ministry experience and a Bachelor's degree in ministry or equivalent education through experience.
- Must have computer skills including knowledge of mainstream word processing programs, Google Suite, Social Media platforms, digital communication methods, and other apps helpful for modern ministry.
