LUKE - JESUS OUR HEALER OF THE BROKEN September 3, 2023 / Pastor Glenn Gunderson

BACKGROUND FOR LUKE

Content: The story of Jesus as part 1 of Luke-Acts; part 1 begins with the announcement of Jesus' birth by the Spirit and carries through to Jesus' ascension to heaven.

Author: According to very early tradition, Luke the physician and companion of the apostle Paul, the only Gentile author in the Bible.

Date: Scholars are divided between a date before the death of Paul in 64 AD and one after the fall of Jerusalem in AD 70.

Recipient(s): Theophilus is otherwise unknown; in keeping with such prefaces in Greco-Roman literature, he was probably the patron of Luke-Acts, thus underwriting its publication; the readers are Gentile Christians, whose place in God's story is ensured through the work of Jesus Christ and the Spirit.

Emphasis: God's Messiah has come to his people, Israel, with the promised inclusion of Gentiles; Jesus came to save the lost, including every kind of marginalized person whom traditional religion would put outside the boundaries; Jesus' ministry is carried out under the power of the Holy Spirit; the necessity of Jesus' death and resurrection (which fulfilled Old Testament promises) for the forgiveness of sins.
