Technical Director

Job Family: Production

Reporting Relationship: Responsible to the Production Director.

Role Summary: Manage AVL (Audio, Video and Lighting) systems and assets of Purpose Church. Manage all technical aspects of productions in the worship center. Responsible for the research, design, installation and maintenance of the AVL systems for the worship center, control room, studios and all spaces using AVL systems at Purpose Church. Train team members and volunteers in use of AVL equipment.

What you'll do:

- Manage all technical aspects and stage setup for weekly worship services in the worship center including audio, video, lighting and music equipment on stage.
- Train paid team members and volunteers.
- Maintain and manage all AVL systems on the Purpose Church campus.
- Research, design and install AVL systems at Purpose Church.
 - This will include executing the install process or overseeing an outsourced contractor(s) for large install projects (ie. hiring and working with a rigger or electrician).
- Assist in creating and operating within the budget for AVL needs to support Purpose Church ministries.
- Coordinate and facilitate technical support for outside groups and special events.
- Various tasks to support the Production Department of Purpose Church. This can vary depending on event schedule and may be more or less depending on the calendared events.

Commitments:

- Must make Purpose Church your home church and agree with the vision, mission, and value statements of Purpose Church.
- Must agree with and abide by the Statement of Faith and Church Practices of Purpose Church.
- Must align with the Culture Values of Purpose Church.
- Must have a passion for using creative methods to spread, teach and support teaching of the gospel & discipleship through the use of digital technology.
- Must have studied and continue to study the Bible for spiritual growth and enrichment and then apply that knowledge to the use of technology in the church and ministries.
- Available to work on Sundays, Easter Weekend, Christmas Events & Special Events as needed.

What you'll need:

- Minimum of four years work experience that overlaps in professional audio, video and lighting systems and equipment.
- Experience with and knowledge of modern professional audio, video and lighting equipment systems and protocols (ie. Dante, DMX & SDI, etc.).
- Must be proficient in time management, deadlines & creative problem solving.

- Foster a positive team (volunteer & paid staff) environment that aligns with the Culture Values and Statement of Faith of Purpose Church.
- Ability to train volunteers (with varying levels of experience) to complete complex tasks efficiently.
- Proficient in use of mobile devices and computers with both Windows and Mac OS.
- Stay up to date with industry software, technical processes and systems.
- Experience with Google Suite, Microsoft Office, Adobe CC, DaVinci Resolve, Vimeo, YouTube, Live Streaming encoders, audio DAWs and Worship Presentation software.
- Understanding and use of proper rigging technologies and practices when flying (hanging) overhead equipment.
- Ability to lift up to 50 pounds and be comfortable with working on heights and in small spaces.
- Basic carpentry and building skills are a plus.
