Jeremiah 9:23-24, 10:6, 10, 12

REFLECT | DISCUSS | PRACTICE

1. **REFLECT:** How did you sense God speaking to you through the sermon and Bible verses?
2. **DISCUSS:** What’s a piece of advice you have been given that at first sounded crazy but with time has proven true?
3. **DISCUSS:** Read Jeremiah 7:1-11. Why do you think religious activity can sometimes become a substitute for a real relationship with God?
4. **DISCUSS:** Read Jeremiah 7:23-24 and Proverbs 3:5-6. What is a “stubborn inclination” you’re struggling with and why is it difficult to distinguish between God’s good inclinations and our sinful ones?
5. **DISCUSS:** Read Jeremiah 8:5-6. Which is harder: recognizing a lie or letting go of it?
6. **DISCUSS:** How does God’s truth make us whole rather than simply make us feel better?
7. **DISCUSS:** Read Jeremiah 9:23-24, 10:6, 10, 12. Which description of God from this passage stands out most to you and why?
8. **PRACTICE:** Ask one trusted Christian friend or family member this question, then thank them for their honesty, and ask God to help you work on that this week: *What’s one area where you see me being different at church than I am elsewhere?*
