REFLECT | DISCUSS | PRACTICE

1. **REFLECT:** How did you sense God speaking to you through the sermon and Bible verses?
2. **DISCUSS:** Read Jeremiah 30:1-7. Jeremiah describes a “time of trouble for Jacob,” yet God promises, “he will be saved out of it.” What “time of trouble” are you walking through right now? How does knowing that God is with you in your trouble, and not just after it, change your perspective?
3. **DISCUSS:** Read Jeremiah 30:17 and Jeremiah 31:11-14. God promises healing, restoration, and joy after sorrow. Have you ever experienced God bringing hope or healing out of a difficult season? What did that teach you about His faithfulness?
4. **DISCUSS:** Read Jeremiah 31:33-34. God promises a New Covenant where He writes His law on our hearts instead of stone tablets. What’s the difference between trying to follow God through rules and following Him because your heart has been changed by Jesus? Which one are you more tempted to rely on?
5. **DISCUSS:** Read Hebrews 8:6-13 and 2 Corinthians 3:7-18. Jesus fulfilled Jeremiah’s promise of the New Covenant. How does knowing that your relationship with God is based on Christ’s finished work, not your perfect performance?
6. **PRACTICE:** This week, identify one area of your life that feels broken, uncertain, or in need of restoration. Instead of trying to fix it on your own, surrender it to Jesus in prayer each day. Then take one intentional step toward Him, whether that’s reading scripture, worshiping, joining community, serving someone, or sharing your testimony. Ask God to continue transforming your heart and remind yourself each day: God isn’t finished with me yet.
