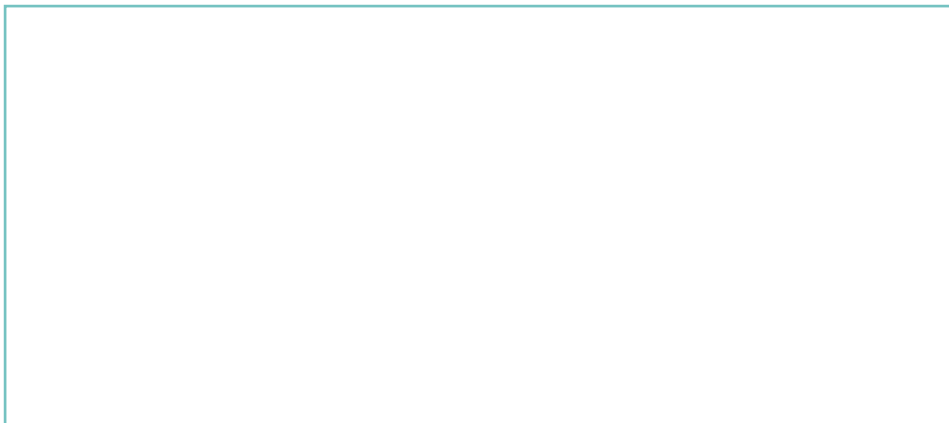

TWO INVITATIONS:

1. RETURN TO THE LORD

2. REMEMBER AND REFLECT



REFLECT | DISCUSS | PRACTICE

1. **REFLECT:** Is there an area of your life where you sense God getting your attention or prompting you to make a change? What might it look like for you to return to God?
2. **REFLECT:** Where do you need to remember that your story isn't over and God is still at work, even if you can't see what He's doing?
3. **REFLECT:** What are three things God has done in your life that you never want to forget? Jeremiah's message wasn't always what the people wanted to hear. Why do you think we sometimes prefer messages that make us comfortable rather than messages that challenge us to return to God?
4. **DISCUSS:** What are some ways people today can forget God's faithfulness? How can we intentionally remember what God has done?
5. **DISCUSS:** Jeremiah ultimately points us toward Jesus—the One who doesn't simply tell us to return to God but makes a way for us to return to God. How does understanding Jesus this way change the way you think about repentance, returning to God, and God's invitation to you?
6. **DISCUSS:** Share with your life group this week the three things God has done for you. Then add to the list throughout the week.
7. **PRACTICE:** Tell one faith story. Share one story of God's faithfulness with a spouse, friend, child, coworker, or grandchild. For parents and caregivers, this could become a dinner-table question: "What's something God has done in our family that we should never forget?"
